Introduction (Access for Mobile)

Access for mobile is integrated into V7R2Mo of IBM i Access for Web. (5770-XH2)

- * V7**R2**Mo of 5770-XH2 is **required** for iaMobile.
- * iaMobile can be installed on V7R1Mo or V6R1Mo.
- * It runs by default in the basic HTTP server *ADMIN.
- * It is a customized version of Access for Web.

Introduction (ACS – Java Client)

IBM i Access Client Solutions is a Java based solution to access most IBM i system functions.

- * The product is 5733-XJ1, currently at version 1.1.4.
- * The will run from a thumb drive.
- * The product is not “installed.”
- * The product can be launched from a remote drive.
- * The product will run on any Java platform.



Started and stopped automatically with the *ADMIN HTTP Server

- * Can be started and stopped individually (r7.1 IBM i OS and later)
- * `STRTCPSVR SERVER(*IAS) INSTANCE(ADMIN5)`
- * `ENDTCPSVR SERVER(*IAS) INSTANCE(ADMIN5)`
- * ADMIN5 runs on port 2011
- * Can be configured on any WebServer instance.
- * My example uses all default settings.





IBM i Access for Web

Welcome to IBM i Access for Web, the lightweight, browser-based access to your IBM i resources.

Pure Java servlet based access

IBM i Access for Web is a set of servlets that run on IBM i platforms as extensions to the HTTP server. The servlets provide access to databases, files, print queues, printer output, and messages contained on the system.

Industry standard protocol

IBM i Access for Web uses the industry standard HTTP and HTTPS protocols instead of proprietary TCP/IP ports and protocols. Firewall issues are much more manageable as a result.

Lightweight access

IBM i Access for Web provides lightweight, and convenient access to IBM i platforms from any Web browser. Most of the IBM i Access for Web functions have minimal browser requirements and work with almost any browser on any platform.

No client code

IBM i Access for Web runs entirely on the IBM i platform. There is no client code to install and manage. Simply install and configure on the system, and access from any Web browser.

Object level security

Access to IBM i resources is based on object level security. Users and groups can only access the data to which they are authorized.

Fully customizable

Access to IBM i Access for Web functionality can be restricted for users and groups of users. IBM i Access for Web is fully customizable so a user will only see and access what the administrator has configured for them to use and see.

Web components

IBM i Access for Web is also a set of Web components for Web applications. Web applications can link to the IBM i Access for Web servlet URLs and take advantage of the functions that IBM i Access for Web provides.
